Whew! I've registered!

Now what happens?

What's the Board doing?

Your Regional Board begins the process of putting the teams together for the upcoming season. When this is completed, Coordinators start to reach out to parents asking for volunteers as coaches for teams. They will also be reaching out to those parents that have already committed to volunteering for a team. Uniforms have been ordered and parents will be notified when they are available for pick up.

When do the coaches get their teams?

Coaches should expect to receive their team rosters at the mandatory coach meeting scheduled *8/19/15 or 8/24/15*. *Coach only need to attend one of the dates.

When do the players get called?

Teams may begin practice on or after the 2nd week of August. The coaches will call the players usually mid-August once they submitted their volunteer form online & completed their safe haven, concussion, & coach training. Coaches will provide you with information regarding practice times & location. Each coach sets his/her own practice days, time & location. Generally the

practice fields are at the Los Lunas Sports Complex.

It's after Aug. 25th, & my child has not been called.

What do I do?

Please do not panic if you see teams practicing & your child has not been called. Not all teams begin practice at the same time. The very young teams (U6 & U5), in particular, do not practice during the week. If your child has not been called by 8/28th, please email your division coordinator.

What else does my child need?

The registration fee includes: complete uniform (jersey, shorts, and socks). In addition, you may need to obtain shoes, shin guards, a soccer ball (size depends on age) and a water bottle.

How often are practices and games?

Practices are typically twice a week depending on the division age (field and times to be determined by your child's coach). Games are on Saturdays. *Opening Day Ceremony & the first game is scheduled for 9/12th*. Parade of teams and Pictures are scheduled on opening day in addition to a player appreciation lunch on this day. We will be

holding a Team Banner contest for those teams that create a team banner for Opening day.

Refund?

Players withdrawing prior to *8/1/15* will be issued a full refund. After *8/2/15* *player refunds will be less uniform costs*. All requests for a refund must be submitted in writing & accompanied with a self-addressed stamped envelope. If self-addressed stamped envelope is not included postage will be deducted from refund payment. Mail to PO Box 279, Los Lunas, NM 87031 or see our handbook (PDF) for the electronic process.

Late registration?

Late registration begins after our last registration on *8/17/15* & *Region Late Registration Policy goes into effect*.
